<sup>(2)</sup> The three months ended September 30, 2021 included \$7 million of additional tax expense, reflecting the cumulative effect of an increase in the annual effective tax rate from the previous quarter estimate.

<sup>(3)</sup> Our effective tax rate is calculated as income tax expense divided by income before income taxes.

<sup>(4)</sup> Our effective tax rate, excluding discrete items, is calculated as income tax expense, excluding various discrete items (such as changes in estimates and tax on items excluded from income before income taxes), divided by income before income tax expense, excluding gains and losses on sales and similar items pursuant to the accounting standards for income taxes related to estimating the annual effective tax rate.
